In addition, John will also discuss and update the specific strategies found in his book, *Mastering the Trade*. Delegates will come away from this session not only with key tools on how to become a successful trader, but also with a specific game plan on what to do the very next trading day.

Strategies for Capturing Consistent Profits in Forex

Profitable forex traders approach the markets in many different ways. This is a rare opportunity to learn to trade forex with real pros.

David Jones, CMC Markets chief market analyst, appears regularly as a market commentator on financial channels such as CNBC. In the first half of this session, he will cover the nuts and bolts issues: what drives these markets, who are the major participants, why do they trade FX, volatility comparison with other markets; and simple strategies such as why delegates should use spread betting to trade FX, using moving averages, charting simple support and resistance lines, advantages of candle charts, risk management, determining how much of your account to risk on any single trade, and considerations before using margin.

Ed Ponsi, FXEducator LLC, president, and former chief trading instructor, Forex Capital Markets (FXCM), is an experienced professional trader and money manager. He has advised hedge funds, institutional traders, and individuals of all levels of skill and experience. In the second half of the session, he will cover forecasting and analysis: major trends and themes; fundamental, intermarket, and technical analysis; as well as intermediate strategies: trading around news and economic announcements; how to determine stop loss points; what to consider when trading exotic currency pairs; determining profit targets; and Fibonacci numbers and why they work.
